4. Findings - Clearly described; Relevant findings highlighted.
5. Analysis & Discussio- Relevant findings discussed in relation to theories /issues/objectives/ literature; Considerations of implications beyond the confines of the research.
6. Conclusions & Recommendations - Retrospective evaluation of research & Contributions; Recommendations for improving the situation; Identification of new directions for further research
7. Overal - Standard of English Language (Score to be above 90%) and Similarity Index (Plagiarism) to be less than 30%, based on [Grammarly](#); Clarity of illustrations; APA style of referencing.

Commencing 2018 the *E-BPJ* shall be published three times annually, excluding Special Issues.
