4. Findings - Clearly described; Relevant findings highlighted.
5. Analysis & Discussio- Relevant findings discussed in relation to theories /issues/objectives/ literature; Considerations of implications beyond the confines of the research.
6. Conclusions & Recommendations - Retrospective evaluation of research & Contributions; Recommendations for improving the situation; Identification of new directions for further research
7. Overall - Standard of English Language (Score to be above 90%) and Similarity Index (Plagiarism) to be less than 30%, based on [Grammarly](#); Clarity of illustrations; APA style of referencing.

Commencing 2018 the *E-BPJ* shall be published three times annually, excluding Special Issues.

Foreword

This AIVECE-BS-1, 2020ShahAlam, managed to attract an overall total of 50 numbers of approved abstracts contributed by six countries, namely Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia and Taiwan.

The abstracts approved were ultimately transformed into 40 approved full papers, a return of 80%. In terms of the top 3 categories of popularity (though the papers could be easily placed within other categories), the Health/Healing Environment was the most popular with 9 papers (22.5%), followed by Commercial/Retail/Services Environment and Landscaping Environment (4 papers each) and Hospitality/Tourism Environment, Residential Environment, Travel/Transportation Environment, and Urban Environment (3 papers each).
