Foreword

The 6th Asia Pacific International Conference on Environment-Behaviour Studies, AicE-Bs2015Barcelona, held at the Barcelona School of Architecture (ETSAB), Universitat Politecnica De Catalunya (UPC), Barcelona, Spain with " *Developments and Social Behaviours*" as the main theme, managed to attract an overall total of 110 numbers of abstracts from 10 countries worldwide.

The final 93 abstracts approved were eventually transformed into 56 approved full papers, a returned rate of 60%. Contributors being from six countries. Majority of the full papers were contributed by authors from Malaysia (77%). This was followed by Iran (11%), Indonesia (5.6%), Egypt (4%) and Australia and Thailand, 1% each.

The full papers approved were simply grouped generally under 16 sub-categories, although quite a number could have been easily placed under more than one category. The top four categories in order of popularity involved the following environments:- Community Environment, ComE (16%), Residential Environment, RE and Urban Environment, UE, (14% each) Health / Healing Environment, HE (13%), and Local Heritage Environment, LHE (9%).

The Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers (AMER), the main organiser of AicE-Bs2015Barcelona, together with the Co-Chair and the Co-Host, Barcelona School of Architecture (ETSAB), Universitat Politecnica De Catalunya (UPC), Barcelona, Spain congratulate all contributors in making the conference a tremendous success!

It should be noted that proceedings of previous international conferences organised by AMER since 2010 were published and accessible online in Elsevier's *Procedia Social and Behavioural Sciences* (ISSN: 1887-428) , www.ScienceDirect.com. Those proceedings have all been indexed in Thomson Reuter's Web of Science (WoS). Commencing 2016, Elseveier shall cease future publicaton of the Procardia *Social and Behavioural Sciences*. Thus, the inevitable but timely birth of the Environment-Behaviour Proceedings Journal (E-BPJ). Mainly, to sustain the publication of the proceedings of forthcoming annual, serial international conferences to be organised by AMER.
