Foreword

This 14th AMER International Conference on Quality of Life (AicQoL2026) being held at the Sunlake Waterfront Resort & Convention, Jakarta, Indonesia, is organised by AMER (Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers), It marked AMER's 52nd international conference to be organised, which is fully managed by AMER's subsidiary, emAs (AMER Event Management & Services) under emAs emAs Resources

The Game Changer 2021 (#GC2021) initiated in early 2021 whereby it is compulsory for contributions from Malaysia to include international co-authors, is to increase our publications to be contributed by multi-national authors. We believe that initiative would tremendously increases the chances for our publications to be indexed by more reputable indexing bodies, such as Scopus. As such, commencing 2021 only multi-national authored contributions from Malaysia shall be accepted for publications.

AicQoL2026Jakarta managed to attract an overall total of 49 numbers of approved abstracts, of which authors from 10 countries contributed. Majority of the abstracts were in collaboration with Malaysian authors. The most were together with Indonesia (26 numbers / 60%); followed by China (7 numbers); Philippines (3), Thailand (2), and Iran, New Zealand, Nigeria, Turkey, and USA (1 each)

The approved abstracts were finally transformed into 36 approved full papers, a return of 73.5%. The papers approved were simply grouped generally under 14 sub-categories, although quite a number could have been easily placed under more than one category. The top three categories in order of popularity involved the Health / Healing Environment (HE) with 8 papers, followed by Educational / Learning Environment (ELE) with 7 papers, and Design / Creative Environment with 4 papers.

Hopefully this conference will inspire and encourage more researchers to participate in our forthcoming serial conferences.

Thanks again for your continuous support and contributions as always, and hope for an enlightening conference!
